Sheffield Steam and Heritage Society would like to offer camping for people attending the 2025 National Rowing Championships from 24<sup>th</sup> to 30 March 2025. Sheffield is 16 kms and a 20 minute drive from Lake Barrington and has Mt Roland as a beautiful backdrop.

The Society can provide accommodation on our grounds at 14 Spring St Sheffield. We have space for approximately 120 unpowered, fully self-contained motor home or caravans, and approximately 30 powered sites and a number of grassy flat areas suitable for camping. The Sheffield Recreation Grounds where the Society is based is not an established caravan park however, we have toilets and showers facilities available in these areas, and water outlets are available from a few taps around the site. A Kentish Council dump point is 60 meters further down Spring Street. The shops of Sheffield including a number of cafes and restaurants are a 10 minute walk from the camping area. Cradle Mountain is an hour's drive away.

The rates will be \$35 unpowered and \$45 powered per night per van. We will not be placing unpowered motorhomes and caravans into the powered sites at this stage. Bookings can be made by ringing Jill Ridgway – Secretary on mob 0448 631 922 – and an invoice will be forwarded for the booking. The booking is finalised once payment is received. Cancellations will be refunded up to 15.03.2025.

The train and steam engines will not be in steam during this week however a ride on the diesel loco can be arranged if there is sufficient interest.
